Create a Family Temple and Family History Plan

In a recent training, the importance of Ward Temple and Family History Plans was emphasized. Developing and implementing the plan is accomplished through the ward council with help from the elders quorum and Relief Society presidents and the ward temple and family history leader. These ward-led efforts are undertaken to unite families for eternity. In our home-centered Church, each family has the opportunity to engage in temple and family history work in specific ways that they need and desire and that will help their family members grow. We can apply the instruction regarding ward plans to prepare our own *family temple and family history plan*. The General Handbook – applied to our families – provides this guidance:

Each [family] should have a simple temple and family history plan. This plan helps [family] members, including children and youth, prepare to worship in the house of the Lord and participate in family history work as often as their circumstances allow. The [father and mother] help the [family] council develop the plan...In developing the plan, they:

- Prayerfully consider [family] members' needs and the available resources.
- Identify actions to take during the year.
- Determine how to implement the plan and make assignments accordingly.

The handbook provides helpful examples of what might be included in the plan – see Section 25.2.6. Individuals and families – based on their unique makeup and needs – may be engaged in family history learning and research, preparing for and receiving own ordinances, and performing proxy ordinances for deceased ancestors – or some combination of these activities. There are opportunities to engage family members of all ages. FamilySearch's <u>Get Involved</u> and <u>Activities</u> pages are great resources – and these are just the tip of the iceberg!

I invite your family to create a Family Temple and Family History Plan. If you need help or ideas in developing or implementing your plan, please reach out to your ward temple and family history leader who can help you and/or engage others as appropriate. The FamilySearch Center and its staff are also resources that are here for you. It is my testimony that as you engage with your family in temple and family history work, your hearts will turn toward one another and to your fathers.

The Lord's work is hastening in the Omaha Stake and throughout the world. Last week 15 brand new missionaries arrived in the Omaha Nebraska Mission and the church announced that effective immediately, sisters can now begin missionary service as young as 18 and completion of high school upon its equivalent. The total number of teaching and service missionaries has surpassed 84,000. Additionally there are over 31,000 Senior Missionaries serving throughout the world. In October, the Church announced the addition of 55 new missions to be created by July 1, 2026 bringing the total missions worldwide to 506. Elder Cook taught us that, "In the last 36 months, nearly 900,000 converts have joined Church. These the converts constitute approximately 5 percent of the total Church membership." We are living in a glorious time as we prepare for the Lord's Second Coming.


