

New Location: Near the Food Court



The 2025 Giving Machine season runs Nov. 25-Dec. 9 at Westroads Mall, now located outside the food court. This year, volunteers will take longer (2.5-3 hour) shifts focused on observing and troubleshooting, not recruiting donors, as the machines will largely be unmanned like vending machines.

Volunteers may sit in the nearby lounge or food court and can bring personal activities (book, laptop, etc.). Kids are not recommended for shifts since involvement is minimal. The first shift starts up the machines, and the last shift refills cards and shuts them down. Afternoon gaps without volunteers are planned, and schedules may adjust as needed.

Evening shifts will be more interactive, involving photos, giveaways, and community events. Volunteers will be identified with buttons, lanyards, or aprons.

Training will cover operation, troubleshooting, and closing procedures. Volunteers are encouraged to sign up for multiple shifts to reduce training needs. If your desired slot is full, add your name to the Substitute Availability list for fill-ins.



- Plan for Power Outages (backup heating, alternative cooking sources)

<u>Family Challenge:</u> Assemble a winter survival kit for your home.









TEMPLE & FAMILY HISTORY MESSAGE



November is a special month to remember. As a stake, we will begin the month with a special Day of the Dead Activity on Saturday, November 1. The traditions of this cultural celebration invite us to honor and remember our deceased loved ones. Building from this celebration, we have an opportunity to continue our remembering throughout the month. Psalm 44:1 reads: "We have heard with our ears, O God, our fathers have told us, what work thou didst in their days, in the times of old." 


