TEMPLE & FAMILY HISTORY MESSAGE

The school year has ended, and summer is here! I am reminded of the summers of my childhood. I am the third of five children, and there were always numerous summer activities. Many of these were informal and started any day (except Sunday) and at any hour of the day with a ring of the doorbell and the repeated question: "Can [insert name] come out and play?". My mother loved that we had wonderful neighbors and friends, but the endless inquiries were unpredictable and sometimes disruptive. To remedy this, she instituted "quiet time". From 1 PM to 3 PM each afternoon, we were to be home and quietly engaged in reading or other similar activities. Our friends quickly learned the new schedule and that any attempt to invite the Omers to play during those hours would yield a polite but firm "not now, it's quiet time".


YOUTH SUMMER TEMPLE & FAMILY HISTORY CLASS





A Temple and Family History Class for younger youth (turning 12 or 13 in 2025) will be held at the Omaha FamilySearch Center on June 24-27! Please see the details below:

- When is the class? Classes will be held Tuesday through Friday, June 24-27. The classes will be held each day in the <u>morning</u> and will be 1 hour in length. Exact times will be determined based on the number of registrants and classes needed; up to three class times will be held each day.
- Who is invited to attend? Young men and young women turning 12 or 13 in 2025 (birth years 2013 and 2012) are invited to attend the class. See Learn More.
- What will be covered? This is a class for beginners and will include instruction and activities in the areas of FamilySearch navigation and use, writing journals and personal histories, research basics, preparing for temple work, and ways to be involved in family history this summer and beyond!
- Where will class be held? The class will be held at the Omaha FamilySearch Center which is located on the north side of the Stake Center.
- **How can I register?** Click <u>REGISTRATION</u>. Parents are encouraged to help their youth through the registration form. Registration will close May 25 (or when classes are full).
- Prerequisites: Participants need a FamilySearch account and need to know or bring their login and password! Youth are able to create accounts with parental permission. Parents, please assist your youth with account setup. See Learn More.


