



#### TEMPLE & FAMILY HISTORY MESSAGE



I have a deep appreciation for the pioneers and for our shared spiritual heritage as members of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. Like many of you, I have had the opportunity to visit Winter Quarters numerous times over the years, learning of the experiences of early Latter-day Saints and their preparation to continue their journey. I returned from my mission in June 1997 as members celebrating were sesquicentennial of the inaugural Mormon Trail journey from Winter Quarters to Salt Lake Valley. I had the opportunity to join a chorus in singing a pioneer cantata, Refuge and Rest, written by Jo Ellen Fankhauser and Dan Carter, as part of local sesquicentennial celebration events. The lyrics describe Winter Quarters as a place where the Saints found reprieve:

Winter Quarters became a special and meaningful place for me as a youth, and this was magnified with the dedication of the temple in 2001. In reflecting on the words of the song, I am struck by the parallels between the pioneer experience and our own. The temple near the river banks – the House of the Lord – is truly a home of solace, safety, refuge, and rest. It is a sacred place for us to make covenants and to worship God. President Russell M. Nelson has taught:

"Spend more time in the temple, and seek to understand how the temple teaches you to rise above this fallen world. ... Cherish and honor your covenants above all other commitments. As you let God prevail in your life, I promise you greater peace, confidence, joy and, yes, rest." (1)

"In the temple, we receive protection from the buffetings of the world. We experience the pure love of Jesus Christ and our Heavenly Father in great abundance. We feel peace and spiritual reassurance, in contrast to the turbulence of the world." (2)

I am grateful for our Winter Quarters – the temple – a place of peace and preparation for our continued journey.


